

- → Ensure your truck and containers are thoroughly clean before and after loading. A clean environment helps prevent contamination.
- → Stick to the clear safety procedures for food and feed transport. This ensures that products stay in top condition throughout the journey.
- Regularly inspect your truck and the load to make sure everything is secure and in good shape before you drive (temperature settings, sealings, etc.) to prevent incidents such as the one in the photo.

### Empowerment Your license to stop activity


